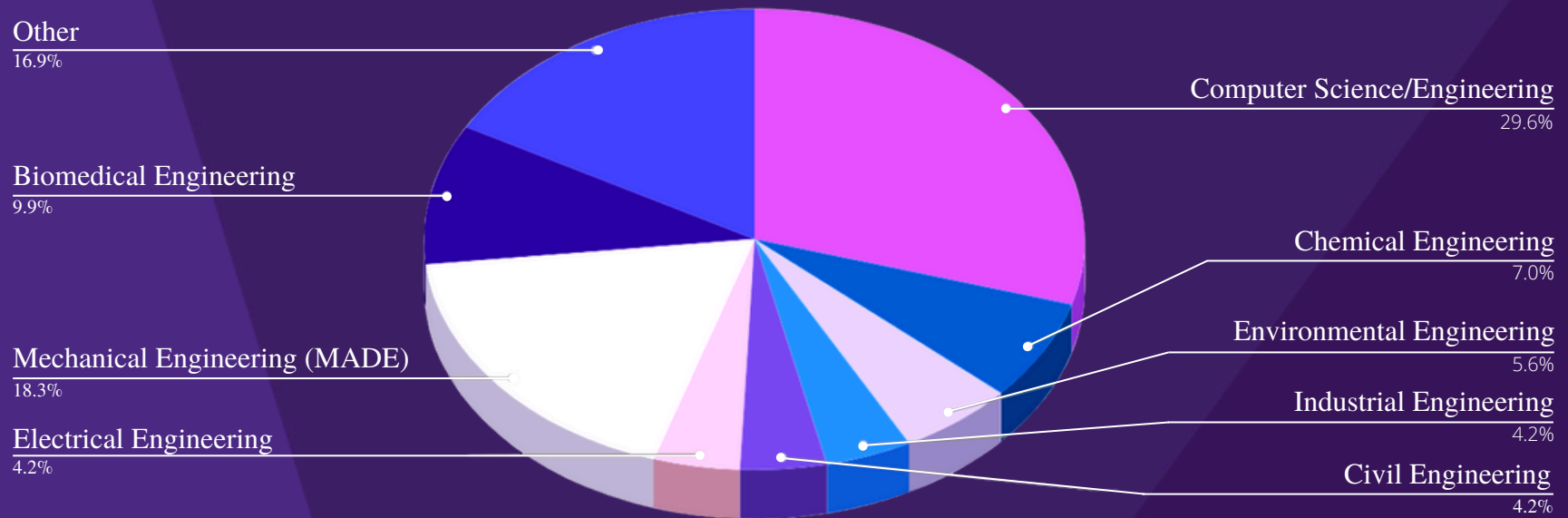

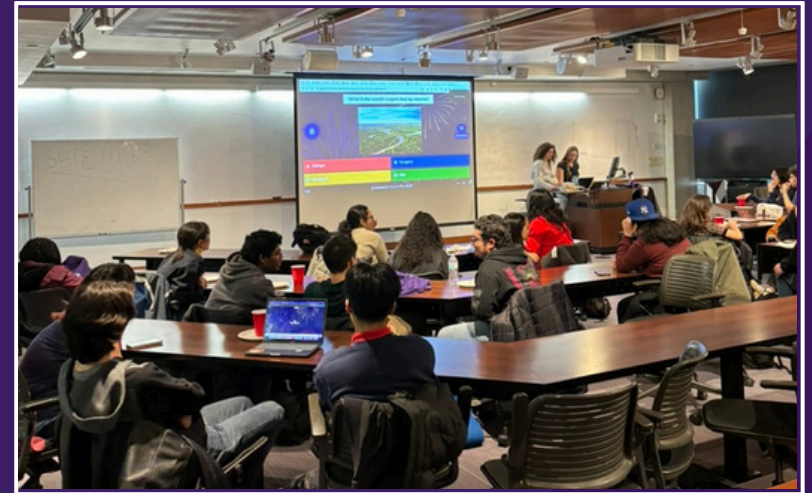
A collaboration with other Hispanic and Latine organizations on campus to celebrate our culture and background.
